Outlaw Enterprise

AQHA and NSBA World Champion Stallion

When you start with a big, strong, beautiful and correct prospect with solid confirmation and a great mind, success follows.

That is exactly the case with AQHA and NSBA World Champion Outlaw Enterprise, a 2017 bay stallion, sired by Iron Enterprise out of Lastminuteinvestment.

Bred by Marcie McClenon, of Dunnellon Florida, Outlaw Enterprise (Cosmo) was purchased as a youngster by Ray Alderman, who sent him to Mark and Judy Zeitler to get started under saddle.

Judy knew very early on that Cosmo had the potential to be a great Hunter Under Saddle performer. She says that his lope is strong suit but he has always had that "it factor" so his job under saddle came easily.

"He was always very willing and easy to teach things to, so athletic and strong," she recalled. "With both Ray and Lauren already in our barn, the ownership transition was seamless."

And so did success in the show pen.

As just a 2-year-old, Cosmo captured his first World Championship title, in the 2-Year-Old Limited Open Hunter Under Saddle at the NSBA World Show.

He followed that up with another title in 2020 when he won the 3-Year-Old Open Hunter Under Saddle Championship at the NSBA World Show.

But his greatest success, Judy says, came at the AQHA World Championship Show that November when he won the Level 3 Junior Hunter Under Saddle.

"That was special for him and for me," she said. "Cosmo knows he's pretty cool but he's also always a gentleman."

Outlaw Enterprise capped off the show season that year with a win in the 3-year-Old Open Hunter Under Saddle at the Tom Powers Futurity in Ocala, Florida.

Then in early 2021 he was bred to a total of 53 mares. Outlaw Enterprise will stand the 2022 breeding season at Pilot Know Stud in Reddick, FL under the supervision of Mike Hay. His 2022 fee is \$1,500. An early booking discount of \$500 applies, making the fee \$1,000 with a 2022 signed contract and paid \$500 non-refundable booking deposit before Dec 31 (with the remainder to be paid in full when first shipment order is placed).

Outlaw Enterprise's foals will be eligible for the NSBA, Premier Sires, Iowa Breeders and the Michigan Breeders.

Lauren Sleik- Vice President

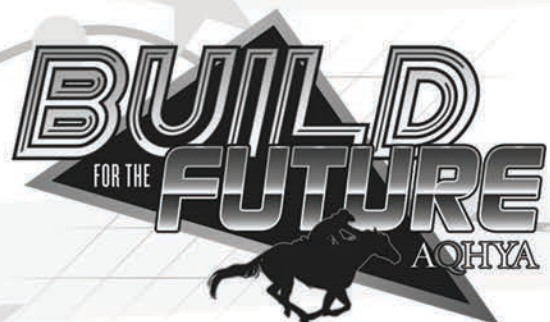

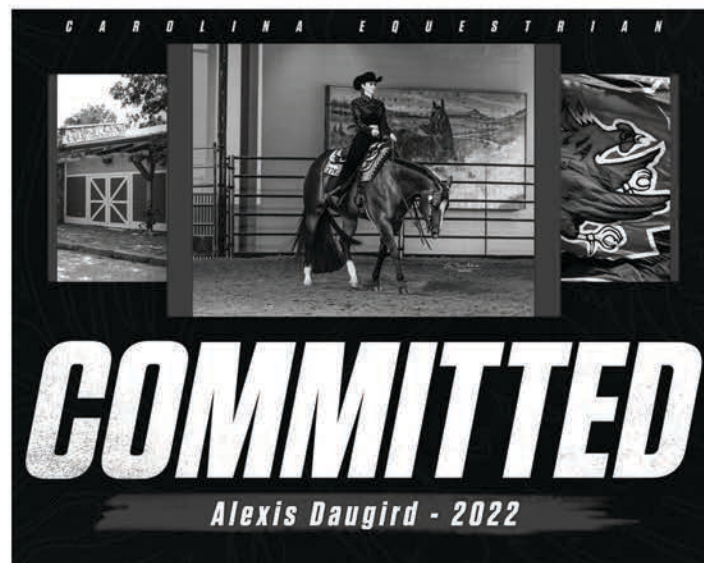

Bill Moomey was born in York, NE, and his path in life took him many places. He was a World War II Navy Pilot, college professor, rodeo bronc rider, University of Nebraska Football star, artist, sculptor, and award winning designer whose work is represented in 15 countries. For us in the horse industry we know him as owner of Coys Bonanza, AQHA 2015 Hall of Fame Inductee, and the first horse chosen to Wisconsin Quarter Horse Associations Hall of Fame in 2001. Bill himself was later inducted into the WQHA Hall of Fame in 2006. Earning AQHA's Leading Breeder in the Nation title for three consecutive years, he bred earners of more than 5,205 AQHA points. He served on many WQHA committees and was the National Director for Wisconsin from 1971-1987. Bill also wrote and illustrated a book "Dad Always Said" and excerpts from his book were often published in the American Quarter Horse Journal. We take a moment to think of Bill and all he has done for the horse industry. He is survived by his loving wife and children.

High Point Champion and Reserve Champion In Each Division

Halter: Eligible class: *Halter*.

Showmanship: Eligible class: *Showmanship*

Walk Trot Performance: Eligible classes: *English walk trot, Western walk jog. Walk Trot classes do not count toward Western, Dressage or Hunt Seat performance division points.*

Hunt Seat Performance: Eligible classes: *Hunt Seat Pleasure/ Equitation, Lunge-line, In-hand trail, Hunter Hack, Equitation Over Fences, Bareback Pleasure Equitation, Disciplined Rail, Egg & Spoon, Pleasure Driving.*

Western Performance: Eligible classes: *Western Pleasure/Horsemanship, Bareback Pleasure/Horsemanship, Trail, In-hand trail, Lunge-line, Reining, Western Riding, Disciplined Rail, Egg & Spoon, Pleasure Driving, Ranch Riding*

Speed Performance: Eligible classes: *Barrels, Poles, Egg & Spoon, Roping, Team Penning or any timed event.*

Tiny Tot Performance: (10 & under -age as of current year) May NOT enter any other division Please designate on point forms discipline ridden (English or Western) for classes so these can be used for future merit program awards. Lead line classes are not permitted for points.

Dressage Performance: (all ages) Points based on percentage received

CUMULATIVE MERIT AWARDS

You may take as many years as you wish to work up to them; based on horse rider combination.

Bronze: Must accumulate 100 points in a division

Silver: Must accumulate 200 points in a division

Gold: Must accumulate 400 points in a division

Supreme: Must accumulate 1000 points in a division

- Horse must be a registered Quarter Horse.
- Exhibitor must be a current WQHA member prior to the show date
- Points/placings are per horse/exhibitor team.
- An annual nomination fee of \$25.00 per division plus registration copy must accompany the initial point form. This is in addition to WQHA membership. Make checks out to WQHA.
- Tiny tot or member of his/her immediate family must be a WQHA member.
- Points accumulated as a tiny tot will transfer to youth. Points accumulated as youth will transfer to adult.
- Points carry over from year to year for the merit and champion divisions; however, all point forms must be received by the open show coordinator within 30 days of the show date or they will not be counted.
- The show year begins October 15th and ends on October 14th of current year. All point forms must be in by October 20th or they will not count.
- Any show which is open to horses of all breeds and all colors can be used for this program. Buckskin, palomino, and state 4-h shows are not eligible.
- Champion and reserve classes also count, so please include them. Please indicate the corresponding division and the number of entries in the class.
- Any show that is double judged counts as two separate shows - double points.
- Point violators will be penalized by not receiving points for that show. Repeated errors will be reviewed by the board and subject to the participant being disqualified for the year end awards.
- Points must be turned in on a WQHA form and each page must be signed by the show secretary. All submitted sheets will be verified.

Born in Lithuania and raised in Germany, Helmut came to the United States with his grandparents when he was 10 years old. He was married in 1971 to Judy O'Brien, and his family continued to grow with the addition of his daughter Jenny in 1974 and his son Kurt in 1976.

In June of 1979 Helmut moved his family to Franksville Wisconsin and began a breeding operation at HL Quarter Horses. Over the next 20 years they stood the stallions including Skippen Nugget, Joshua Moon, Barlink Frosty Boy, Red Sonny Rider and Speedy Leaguer. Speedy Leaguer was inducted into the WQHA Hall of Fame in 2013.

Helmut and his family were very active in all the WQHA events and Helmut was a member of the WQHA Board of Directors and Committees. In addition to showing and breeding Helmut held judges cards for AQHA, APHA, NSBA, ApHC, PHBA and ABRA.

Helmut also enjoys raising other animals and birds Jenny says in an article with InStride Edition: "Along with the Zebu cattle, which occupy the front pasture, my father also raises a large variety of birds including a pair of emu and different breeds of pheasants, chickens, doves, pigeons and quail. There are also several peacocks roaming the property. Mr. Piggles, the family's pet pig, who has free reign over the farm, will likely greet you at your car."

Now retired to Florida, where his daughter Jenny trains, Helmut still looks forward to visiting his son Kurt and all his Wisconsin friends.

2021 Inductee Jim McKillips



Jim McKillips was born in 1944 in Beloit, WI, and is the son of 2017 WQHA Hall of Fame Inductees, Robert & Eleanor McKillips.

Jim began his equine career in the late 1950's showing ponies out of the Meri-J Ranch in Beloit WI.

In the late 1960's, Jim made the move from showing ponies to Quarter Horses. It was at this time that Jim became a member of the WQHA. His first customer was Burt Lans, who remained a customer, advisor, and friend throughout his life. After Burt's passing in 2001, Burt's son, Bruce, has continued that relationship with Jim. The Lans family has played a key role in Jim's career.

As a young horse trainer, Jim's first major event win came in October of 1973. Jim led Hy Jules Dandy to win the 3-year-old stallion class at the All-American Quarter Horse Congress, with Hy Jules Dandy also being crowned the Congress Grand Champion Stallion.

Jim has served and supported the WQHA for over 50 years. He and his family hosted AQHA shows at the Meri-J Ranch for almost two decades. Jim has served as the WQHA Youth Advisor to which he would hold weeklong Horsemanship Clinics each summer to teach and help the

WQHYA members to become more competitive not only on a local level, but at a national level. Some that attended his summer clinics are in this room this evening. Jim was the key figure behind the introduction and implementation of the Stallion Service Auction to the WQHA. For numerous years Jim and his committee brought in some of the best-known stallions in the AQHA. This allowed the WQHA futurity to grow at such a rapid pace that the WQHA State Show and Futurity had to be held at the Wisconsin State Fair Park in Milwaukee, the only facility in the state that was large enough to host the event at that time. There would be hundreds of SSA futurity entries.

Jim has been a mentor to several of today's well known and successful horse trainers and judges. A few of those are Bruce Walquist, Patty Campbell, Judy Davis, Kenny Langmeier, Kathy Smallwood, Alyse Roberts, along with numerous others. Jim's list of successful youth and amateur exhibitors is extensive, with many of them having achieved multiple Congress Championships and both AQYHA & AQHA World Championship titles. We would be here all night if we were to read the names of all the successful show horses Jim has either bred, raised, trained, or shown. Many of the horses winning at the National Level today are the direct offspring of Jim's breeding program. Jim believed the key to a great breeding program had to start with the mare. Anyone that knows Jim – knows that "Mare Power" is at the core of his beliefs.

Jim has two children, both of which are active in the horse industry. His daughter, Tracy Alderman, shows in Amateur and Non-Pro events and Jim's son-in-law, Ray Alderman, continues to buy & sell futurity prospects. Jim's son Ryan operates McKillip's Show Horses along with his wife Dodie in Chittenango, New York. Jim's granddaughter Aubrey Alderman continues the family tradition. Aubrey was selected as the Most Outstanding Player in the Horsemanship at the 2021 NCEA Equestrian finals and was also selected to the NCEA finals all-tournament team in both the Horsemanship and Reining. Aubrey was also chosen as the 2021 Female Student Athlete of the year at SMU. Jim's grandson, Grant Alderman, owns and operates Gen Four Distributors, a dairy products distribution company, in Union Grove WI. Jim's grandson, Wyatt McKillips, at age three, is currently preparing for the starting quarterback position for the Chittenango High School Bears. Jim's sister Meri and her husband Butch reside in Collinsville, OK. Meri is an AQHA, APHA, and NSBA Judge.

Over the last 50+ years, it was extremely rare for Jim to ever miss a WQHA horse show. However, that happened in May of 2021 as Jim was recovering from a terrible battle with Covid-19. Jim spent 14 weeks in the hospital, some of that time on a ventilator. Once released from the hospital, his only concern was to get better and get back to the show arena, which he accomplished by attending and showing at the 2021 WQHA State Show.

2021 Inductee Storm Commander



Storm Commander, affectionately known as Ralph, was born in 1985 and was a member of the Schwab family for the majority of his life. He was purchased in 1994 to be Becki's youth horse, but became so much more than her show partner. Ralph was bred by White Birch Farm in Illinois and started his show career on the Wisconsin and Illinois Quarter Horse Circuits. In 1987, he was the High Point Two-Year Old Snaffle Bit Horse in WQHA for George Laidlaw. Ralph then became the youth horse of Andrea Gold in Michigan, prior to being purchased as Becki's youth horse in 1994. Becki was just seven years old when she and Ralph started their show career in the 13 and under classes. After showing in the

walk-trot classes at four and five years old and the 13 and under classes at six years old with Chackeys Harco. Seven-year-old, Becki, was thrilled with her new partnership with Ralph in the all-around events. That year, Becki and Ralph competed at their first Congress in the 11 and under Showmanship, Pleasure, and Hunter Under Saddle. At eight years old, Becki and Ralph placed 4th at the Congress in the NYATT Showmanship, making Becki the youngest exhibitor, at the time, to place in the top-ten in the NYATT. Becki and Ralph went on to win many more Congress medals, Year-End High Point Awards, All-Around Youth Titles, Superior Event Titles, and about a thousand AQHA points. However, Becki most treasured her relationship with Ralph, her horse of a lifetime!

Ralph was also an incredible AQHA ambassador! Following his retirement from major AQHA competition, Ralph faithfully and carefully carried a handicapped rider to many AQHA Medals in Equestrians with Disabilities classes, as well as being a faithful mount for several Walk-Trot kids. Ralph was also used as a therapy horse...most notably for two young boys from Milwaukee who witnessed the murder of their mother. The boys had not spoken a word since the horrific incident; but, riding double on Ralph during therapy sessions with Ralph and their therapist, the boys' faces lit up with smiles ear to ear and finally started talking again. Their excitement and enthusiasm for their sessions with Ralph were a true testament for what equine therapy can do for repairing the heart and soul!

Ralph also became a 4-H ambassador, taking 4-Hers to many State Championships and as a Horseless Horse mount for many young, budding equestrians in 4-H. Ralph inspired a number of young 4-ers to go on to horse ownership...and several who went on to compete in AQHA competition. There is a traveling trophy awarded each year at the Sheboygan County Fair in honor of Ralph named the Storm Commander Equine Service Award to recognize equine service.

Ralph was also an AQHA school ambassador. He and Becki visited elementary schools to help teach students about horses. Becki and Ralph helped many hundreds of elementary students learn about horse care and horsemanship. Further testament to Ralph's incredible nature was coming out of retirement at 29 years old...at a time that his human family truly needed him! During a devastating time for Becki's dad, Roy, Ralph dug deep into his horse show soul to again show his heart of a champion. Becki encouraged her dad to take Ralph along to the Badger Quarter Horse show, just to ride around and enjoy. After riding around at the show, Becki saw Ralph and her dad were loving their time riding around in the warm-up pen. Becki suggested that Roy just take Ralph in the Horsemanship and Showmanship for the fun of it. They showed in both and won classes of 20 horses in each...earning over 20 AQHA points and more importantly, giving Roy a boost that he really needed! This led to a call from AQHA the next weeks with AQHA saying that there must have been a mistake in 29-year-old Storm Commander earning over 20 AQHA points and that they had him listed as dead. Becki assured AQHA that Storm Commander was not dead and that he earned every one of those points! Go Horseshow heard about all of this and did an article on Ralph's incredible achievement at 29 years old that was one of their top articles of 2018.

A few weeks after the Badger show, Ralph was part of Becki's beautiful wedding to Josh, helping to make the day amazing and complete!

Ralph remained very sound until the last year of his 33 years. Whenever Becki needed a "pick-me-up" after a hard day, she would throw a leg over Ralph and ride around bareback for some Ralph therapy.

Following complications of a ruptured colon, Ralph was humanely put to rest on October 31, 2018 and was cremated. His ashes remain in a place of honor. Now, in addition to the fun spectacle of Halloween, the Schwab/Janezick family celebrates the incredible spirit of Storm Commander on October 31st. Ralph was truly a horse of a lifetime for the Schwab family!

WQHA Bylaws

Article I

Name and Purpose

This organization shall be known as the Wisconsin Quarter Horse Association, Inc., hereinafter referred to in these bylaws as the Association. The Association shall at all times be operated and conducted as a not-for-profit corporation in accordance with the laws of the State of Wisconsin pertaining to such organizations and by which it will acquire such rights as granted to associations of this kind. The purpose of this association shall be to promote in all ways the interest of the American Quarter Horse; to increase the number of breeders, exhibitors, and pleasure riders; to advance all events in which American Quarter Horses are shown or raced; and to do any and all things necessary to advance general interest and knowledge of the American Quarter Horse in Wisconsin.

Article II

Relationship to Parent Organization

The Association shall aspire to be the official affiliate of AQHA. All proceedings of the Association shall be in harmony with the policies and activities of the American Quarter Horse Association.

Article III

Membership

Membership shall be open to an individual, family, partnership, farm, firm, or corporation within or outside the state of Wisconsin. Only Wisconsin residents may be elected to office. Members of the Association shall become subject to the rules and the bylaws then in force or later adopted by the Association, and shall be subject to disciplinary action by the Association as provided by these bylaws. A family membership shall include husband and wife, parent or legal guardian, legal domestic partnership and children 18 years of age and under. All members of the family and farm name, if any, must be designated. A single membership shall be open to persons of any age. Family, farm, partnership, and corporation memberships must designate on the membership application two (2) people to represent said memberships on voting matters. Annual membership categories shall include single, family, partnership, farm, firm, or corporation. A lifetime family membership shall also be available. All annual memberships expire on December 31st. All annual memberships become effective on the postmarked date of payment or actual date of transaction. If a membership is renewed or received after the last day of the current show season, that membership will receive the benefits for the remainder of the current year and the following year.

Annual dues for continuing members are due and payable on January 1 of each year; all annual memberships become effective on the postmarked date of payment or actual date of transaction and are not retroactive. Dues shall be set and reviewed from time to time by the Board of Directors.

Article IV

Districts

The State of Wisconsin shall be divided into six (6) districts as follows:

DISTRICT 1 shall consist of Ashland, Barron, Bayfield, Burnett, Chippewa, Clark, Douglas, Dunn, Eau Claire, Iron, Lincoln, Marathon, Oneida, Pepin, Peirce, Polk, Portage, Rusk, St. Croix, Sawyer, Taylor, Vilas, Washburn and Wood counties.

DISTRICT 2 shall consist of Brown, Door, Florence, Forest, Kewaunee, Langlade, Marinette, Menomonie, Oconto, Outagamie, Shawano, Waupaca and Winnebago counties.

DISTRICT 3 shall consist of Calumet Fond du Lac, Manitowoc, Ozaukee, Sheboygan and Washington counties.

DISTRICT 4 shall consist of Adams, Buffalo, Columbia, Crawford, Dodge, Green Lake, Jackson, Juneau, La Crosse, Marquette, Monroe, Richland, Sauk, Trempealeau, Vernon and Waushara counties.

DISTRICT 5 shall consist of Dane, Grant, Green, Iowa, Jefferson, LaFayette, and Rock counties.

DISTRICT 6 shall consist of Kenosha, Milwaukee, Racine, Walworth and Waukesha counties.

Article V

Officers

The officers of the Association shall be President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer. The President shall preside at all regular and special meetings and perform such other duties as are customary to the office of President. The Vice-President shall assume the duties of the President when he/she is absent from a meeting or is unable to act for other reasons. The Secretary shall perform the customary duties pertaining to such offices subject to the authority of the Board of Directors. The treasurer shall be appointed by the Board of Directors. The appointed treasurer shall have previous experience in accounting and shall be knowledgeable and familiar with accepted accounting procedures. The appointed treasurer will be a ~~non~~-voting member of the Board of Directors and shall ~~not~~ be included when establishing a quorum.

Terms of Office

The President shall be elected for a two-year term; the other officers shall be elected for a one-year term.

Article VI

Regional Vice-Presidents

The number of regional Vice-Presidents shall be three (3). One Vice-President shall be elected by the members residing in districts 1 and 2. One Vice-President shall be elected by the members residing in districts 3 and 4. One Vice-President shall be elected by the members residing in districts 5 and 6. Each Regional Vice-President shall assist the District Directors in his/her region, provide help with shows if requested, and see that the District Directors call meetings in October in the respective districts to nominate one or more candidates for District Director and one or more candidates for Regional Vice-President to be placed on the ballot for the annual election.

Article VII

District Directors

Each district shall elect one or more persons to serve as District Directors in the ratio of one Director per 50 membership votes, i.e. one Director for 1-50 membership votes; 2 Directors for 51-100 membership votes; and 3 Directors for any number over 100 membership votes. The number of Directors

representing each of the Wisconsin districts shall be determined by the total number of membership votes in each district on October 1st of the previous year. The duty of the District Director shall be to serve on the Board of Directors and vote on such matters as come before the Board. Each elected Director shall have the right to select an alternate from his/her district to attend and vote at meetings of the Board of Directors which the Director is unable to attend. In case of vacancy due to death, resignation, suspension, or a move from the district, The Board of Directors shall by a majority vote of the entire Board, elect a successor from the respective district to serve until the next regular annual meeting.

Article VIII

National Directors

Candidates for National Director for the state of Wisconsin may be nominated by the Association membership for approval by the American Quarter Horse Association. The National Directors from Wisconsin and any honorary AQHA Vice-Presidents residing in Wisconsin may be asked to serve as voting members of the Board of Directors. In return for their voting privileges, their duties shall be:

- a) To consider any question brought to them by any member residing in the state and to willingly give their counsel and advice;
- b) To bring to the attention of the AQHA any question or problem which cannot be resolved by the state Board of Directors and follow through until resolution;
- c) To update the WQHA Board of Directors at meetings held thru out the year. If unable to attend, a report shall be emailed to the Board prior to the meeting.
- d) To report to the membership pertinent details of the AQHA annual convention. This report shall be published in the minutes of the Association on the WQHA website. The responsibilities of the National Directors in the American Quarter Horse Association are outlined in the AQHA rule book. The Board of Directors may reimburse travel expenditures of the National Directors with prior approval.

When a vacancy occurs in the AQHA National Directorship for Wisconsin and due notification of the vacancy has been received from the AQHA, an election to establish a nominee from the state of Wisconsin to fill this vacancy shall be conducted. The nominations shall follow the process indicated in Article XI of the bylaws. The individual selected as the Wisconsin nominee in the voting process will be the candidate nominated by the WQHA to the AQHA nominating and credentials committee. The AQHA nominating and credentials committee will select the National Director from a list of candidates including the WQHA Nominee.

Article IX

Board of Directors

The Board of Directors shall consist of the elected Officers, the three Regional Vice-Presidents, the District Directors, the Immediate Past President, the National Directors, Directors-at-Large, Directors Emeritus and Honorary AQHA Vice-Presidents residing in Wisconsin. The general management of the Association shall be conducted by the Board of Directors. The term of office of the Board of Directors shall be one (1) year beginning January 1. Meetings of the Board shall be called by the president at such time as he/she feels is necessary. At least one meeting shall be called and convened every sixty (60) days. If the President does not call this meeting, it may be called by any five (5) Directors of the Board. Notice of meetings of the Board of Directors shall be given in a reasonable time to each Director by mail, telephone, fax or e-mail. Reasonable notice and the method of giving notice shall be determined by the President and the Secretary, keeping in mind the urgency of the business to be conducted. Location of the meeting shall be determined by the President. A majority of the Board (including alternates) shall constitute a quorum for conducting business. The ex-officio members of the Board (past president, National Directors, Directors-at-Large, Directors Emeritus, and Honorary AQHA Vice-Presidents) shall not be counted in the quorum but their votes shall count in the conduct of business. If any member of the Board of Directors misses three (3) consecutive meetings ~~without a valid excuse or without sending an alternate, this Board member may shall be removed from office and shall not be eligible for office for a one-year term. at the discretion of the Board of Directors, and~~ A successor shall be appointed by the Board to serve the remaining term of office. Any District Director or Regional Vice-President may be removed from office at any time by a majority vote of the members in his/her district or region at a meeting called for that purpose, provided at least a ten (10) day notice has been given in writing to each member of that district or region. An officer of this Association may be removed at any time by a majority vote of the general membership attending a meeting called for that purpose, provided at least a ten (10) day notice has been given in writing to each member of the Association. The quorum for this action shall be that as defined in Article XIX Section 2 of these bylaws.

Article X

Executive Committee

The Executive Committee (EC) shall consist of the elected Officers and the Regional Vice-Presidents. Only one member of a family (husband, wife and children 18 years of age and under) may serve as a voting member of the Executive Committee at any time. The Executive Committee shall act on behalf of the Board to conduct the day-to-day business of the Association which does not require a full meeting of the board. Meetings of the Executive Committee shall be held at the discretion of the President as required to conduct the business of the Association. The agenda of the Executive Committee meetings shall be communicated to the Board of Directors one week prior to the meeting of the committee. Location of the meetings shall be determined by the President. A majority of the Executive Committee shall constitute a quorum for conducting business.

Article XI

Elections

A nominating committee, consisting of the Regional Vice-Presidents, shall prepare a slate of nominees for officers of the Association. The nominee for President must have experience as a member of the WQHA board. At district meetings held prior to the annual meeting, nominees shall be selected from the floor for the offices of District Director and Regional Vice-President. The nominating member must reside in the nominee's district or region. All nominees shall be presented at the annual meeting by the Elections Committee. Additional nominations for all positions may be taken from the floor providing the nominator and nominee are current members of WQHA. The election of the Board of Directors (Officers, District Directors, Regional Vice-Presidents), and the confirmation of a National Director Nominee, shall be by mail ballot. Ballots shall be mailed within two (2) weeks of the annual meeting to all members in good standing of the Wisconsin Quarter Horse Association. There shall be space on the ballot for write-in candidates. Ballots shall include the date of the December Board of Directors meeting at which the votes will be validated.

Each member shall vote for all Officers and for the District Directors and Regional Vice-President from his/her respective district and region. A family, partnership, farm, firm or corporation membership shall be allowed two (2) votes; a single membership is allowed one (1) vote. All marked ballots shall be

placed in a sealed envelope and received by the Election Committee at the designated address by the first Saturday of December. Ballots will be counted and election results validated by an in-person meeting of at least three members of the Executive Committee. The Election Committee chairperson appointed by the EC shall present the results of the voting at the December meeting of the Board of Directors. The Board shall consider any election challenges and shall validate election results. The decision of the board is final.

If at the close of nominations at the duly held annual meeting, there are no contested positions, the Executive Officer may call for a vote of acclamation from the floor, this vote will supersede the mailing of ballots and nominated officers and directors will stand as elected. This process will only be used in lieu of a ballot vote when there are no contested positions. If upon the close of nominations there are no contested races for Executive Committee Members, the chair may call for a vote of the members present to elect the Executive Committee and advise the elections committee to mail ballots to the respective districts with contested races for District Director.

Article XII

Committees

Various committees and their chairpersons may be appointed by the president and approved by the Board to help conduct the business of the Association. Committee chairpersons may attend any meetings of the Board as non-voting members. Committee chairs are required to submit a proposed budget for approval by the Board of Directors. ~~Committees are to submit a report for all Board of Director Meetings.~~ All committees shall report to the Board on their activities and recommend policy changes to the Board. All expenditures beyond the budgeted amount for the committee must be approved by the Board prior to the expenditure. All financial transactions conducted by committees (i.e. disbursements and receivables) will be conducted through the office of the WQHA treasurer. Chairpersons must submit a financial report to the Board at the conclusion of their committee's activities for the current fiscal year. Committees shall be required to turn over all hard copy and digital files to the WQHA Board of Directors upon request at completion of the committee's activities, or upon chairperson's resignation. Any member of a committee who fails to perform his/her duties may be removed from the committee by a two-thirds vote of the Executive Committee.

Article XIII

Meetings

The annual meeting of the Association shall be held at a location and time determined by the President, not prior to the second Saturday in October, nor later than the second Saturday in November. Notice of the annual meeting shall be published in the calendar of events on the WQHA website, emailed and/or mailed. The annual awards banquet shall be held on a date approved by the Board of Directors. District members select nominees for district office. In addition to the annual meeting, a general membership meeting may be held in the spring if called by the Board of Directors with proper notice to the membership.

Special meetings may be called by the President or by any five (5) members of the Board of Directors with at least a ten (10) day written notice and an agenda indicating the purpose of the meeting. At all meetings of the Association, holders of a family, partnership, farm, firm or corporation membership shall be allowed two (2) votes provided the designated representatives are present; holders of a single membership shall be allowed one (1) vote. Proxy votes will be accepted for any member in good standing provided that the presiding officer has a signed statement authorizing the proxy vote. Board members attending via teleconference or virtually, shall have one vote and will count towards a quorum. In the event that a quorum is not present for a Board of Directors meeting, members in attendance from a director's home district may be appointed by the presiding officer to proxy for that director provided that no district may be represented by more than their allotted votes.

Article XIV

Employees

Some paid positions are necessary for the day-to-day operations of the Association. The Board of Directors shall review all applications for paid positions and hire applicants on a yearly basis by a majority vote. Applications for paid positions shall be submitted no later than October 30 of each year. Employee contracts shall run from January 1 through December 31 each year. Paid positions shall receive compensations including salary and office expenses as determined by the Board of Directors. All paid ~~and unpaid~~ positions shall submit a written ~~monthly~~ report for each Board of Directors meeting. All paid positions, paid or unpaid, shall be required to turn over all hard copy and digital files to the WQHA Board of Directors upon request, annually upon completion of term, or upon resignation.

Article XV

Disciplinary Action

Any person placed under disciplinary sanction by the American Quarter Horse Association, i.e. expulsion, suspension, etc. is automatically placed under sanction by the Association. Sanctions shall apply to all Association activities, i.e. show, futurities, etc.,. Disciplinary restrictions imposed by the Association shall conform to the restrictions imposed by the AQHA. The following acts and proof of their commission established to the satisfaction of the Board of Directors shall be sufficient grounds for suspension or expulsion of any member from the Wisconsin Quarter Horse Association: Not paying or giving a worthless check for entry fees, office charges, stall charges, stock charges, advertising payments and any other fees or debts delinquent over 90 days, provided that the members are provided with written notice by certified mail of the impending suspension. Board of Directors request for a hearing must be made in writing to the President within 15 days of receipt of the suspension notice. Any member is entitled to a fair and impartial public hearing to appeal a potential suspension or expulsion prior to a vote by the Board of Directors. Notification of suspension or expulsion shall be by certified mail, return receipt requested. A member suspended or expelled by this Association may be reinstated by a majority vote of the Board of Directors. Reinstatement following sanctions imposed by the AQHA shall require written proof of reinstatement by the AQHA and approval of the Executive Committee of the WQHA.

Article XVI

WQHA State Show

The annual Wisconsin Quarter Horse Association State Show shall be held as approved by the American Quarter Horse Association.

Article XVII

Fiscal Year

The fiscal year of the Association shall be from January 1 through December 31.

Article XVIII

Contracts

Written contracts of the Association shall be executed on behalf of the Association by the President, provided they are reviewed and approved by the Executive Committee and/or the Board of Directors.

Article XIX

Amendments

These bylaws may be amended in either of the following ways:

1) At any annual or general meeting of the Association by a majority vote of those present and voting provided that:

- a) the amendment has been approved and recommended by a majority of the Board of Directors present at a properly convened meeting and
- b) all proposed amendments have been published on the WQHA website and/or emailed to the membership prior to the meeting at which they are to be voted on; or

2) At any annual or general meeting by three-fourths of the members present and voting provided there is a quorum of one-fourth of the membership from within the state of Wisconsin. A proxy (as defined in Article XIII) shall be counted toward the quorum.

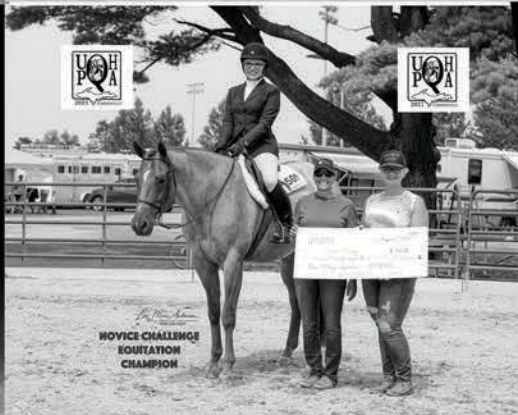
3) If unforeseen circumstances arise affecting the way business is conducted by the Wisconsin Quarter Horse Association or the By-Laws of the Wisconsin Quarter Horse Association a temporary change to an Amendment can be made providing number 1 or 2 under Article XIX is followed and a time frame is stated when it pertains to a specific year or circumstance.

Article XX

Dissolution of the Association

In the recent event that the Association is dissolved for any reason, the assets of the corporation shall be designated for the American Quarter Horse Youth Association Scholarship Fund.

2022 WQHA SHOW & CONTEST - RULES & REQUIREMENTS

1. It is understood that all shows requesting approval of the Wisconsin Quarter Horse Association must be approved by the American Quarter Horse Association. However, a show may apply for WQHA approval before receiving AQHA approval by marking the show application "AQHA approval pending." (NOTE: In order to obtain AQHA approval, an "Application for Approval" form, properly completed, shall be forwarded to the Secretary of the AQHA Association at least ninety (90) days prior to the first date of the proposed show or contest. Such blank forms and other information may be obtained from the American Quarter Horse Association, Amarillo, Texas 79168).
2. Applications for show approval must be filed with the Show Coordinator by March 1 of the approval year. Applications can consist of either oral or written intentions to hold said shows. Every show must send a representative to the Show Coordination seminar that is held before the start of the show season, or at the discretion of the WQHA board, the shows may be refused approval. All WQHA approved shows will use the approved computer program and back number system. The WQHA will have a 55-show limit for approvals and will limit and discourage the approval of shows being held on weekdays. No current year shows will be held after the last weekend in October. WQHA approved shows may either obtain insurance thru the WQHA insurance provider, or if they choose to use a different carrier provide the WQHA with a Certificate of Liability Insurance.
3. A show flyer for printing in the Newsletter should be sent to the WQHA Newsletter Coordinator by due date. If not received by then, neither the Newsletter Editor, nor the WQHA can be held responsible if the show information does not reach the exhibitors on time. Show management agrees to pay the Newsletters fee for printing a flyer, payment must accompany flyer. Shows run on consecutive days with identical show programs may submit one flyer only and will be charged for printing just one flyer. This does not apply to the same management running shows on different weekends throughout the year.
4. No show will start later than 15 minutes after published starting time. If the starting time is more than 15 minutes later without a valid reason, as determined by the WQHA Board of Directors, show approval for the following year may be withheld.
5. At a show there is to be no longeing in the designated show area and make up arena during show hours, this includes all breaks. Show management may make changes because of weather.
6. At a show there is to be no ponying of horses in the designated show area or makeup arena during show hours, this includes all breaks.
7. If working hunter classes are offered at a show, a scheduled practice time for working hunters only will be provided. No riders on the flat or longeing will be allowed in the pen during this time. There will be no jumping practice during open practice sessions when the pen is open for riders on the flat and people longeing.
8. If pleasure driving is offered at the show, a scheduled warm-up and practice time will be made available for driving horses only. No riders or longeing will be allowed in the arena or pen during the pleasure driving warm-up.
9. All exhibitors and horses must be clear of arenas and pens before tractors and arena maintenance equipment can proceed with work.
10. There is no required order for halter classes.
11. All WQHA required classes and optional classes selected must be judged, laid out and operated in accordance with WQHA requirements. The AQHA approved classes must be run according to the rules set forth in the latest edition of the Show and Contest Rules and Regulations of the American Quarter Horse Association. All classes must be on the published show bill to be recognized for WQHA year end points. All WQHA approved classes are eligible as point classes for yearend WQHA awards, providing they are offered under 10 judges.
12. Each WQHA approved horse show will submit a fee in the amount of \$1.00 (one dollar) per horse show entry to the WQHA, payable within 15 days of the end of the show. This fee is incorporated into the WQHA yearend awards program.
13. Show results and fees received after the 15 day limit but before the 30 days will result in the forfeiture of show date preference for the following year. Failure to forward show results and fees after 30 days will result in not approving the show in succeeding years, at the discretion of the Board of Directors. Shows found in violation of this rule will be granted approval only with the estimated total \$1.00 fee paid in advance by March 1 of the approval year. An estimate will be derived from an average of previous year's charges.
14. Sale dates reserved with the WQHA will require a \$25.00 non-refundable fee, payable to the WQHA and forwarded to the Show Coordinator. A full page ad regarding the sale must be published in the Newsletter in order that the date be reserved by the WQHA. Sale Management agrees to pay the Newsletter fee for the full-page ad. No WQHA approved show will be run to conflict with a sale date reserved in this manner.
15. No more than one show or sale will be approved for one date by the WQHA. WQHA shows and sales approved the previous year will have priority over other shows applying for approval, provided they met all WQHA rules the previous year and meet the current show approval policies of the WQHA.
16. It is suggested that judges be from out of state. It is recommended that judges not be from a neighboring state. It is also required that they judge no more than one Wisconsin show per year. In the event of a show emergency, this rule may be waived to accommodate substitute judges.
17. All shows requesting approval must do so with the Show Coordinator by March 1 of the approval year; shows requested after March 1 of the approval year will be considered for the following year's approval with no exceptions. The show calendar will be prepared for publication in the Spring Newsletter.

18. Hardship Clause: Because in any given situation there might arise extenuating circumstances which might be cause to except one or more of these rules in order to grant approval of a show, the committee reserves the right to do so in cases that do not in any manner conflict with the purposes, policies and intent of the WQHA.

19. Suggestions for show grounds, facilities, and class schedules are supplied in the AQHA Show Manager's Guide. New shows applying for WQHA approval may be subject to inspection of same, prior to final approval. Inspection will be conducted by a person(s) appointed by the WQHA Show Coordination Committee.

20. Halter and Performance Classes are point classes for year-end WQHA awards, providing they are offered under 10 judges during the current year at approved shows. At the option of each show and where allowed by AQHA rules performance classes may be offered as Junior and Senior divisions and eligible for WQHA year-end awards providing they are offered under 10 judges during the current year at approved shows.

21. Year-end awards are to be presented to the high point horse in each WQHA approved performance and halter class with a suitable award to the second (reserve) high point in each WQHA approved class. Any first or second place horse that was not shown to at least 10 judges and earned at least 20 WQHA points in that class during the current year at approved shows will receive a lesser year end award.

21A. At show management's option, any number of classes from the full slate of Amateur performance classes may also be offered as Amateur Select ages 50 and over. Management will combine these classes back to an all-age class should there be fewer than 3 entries in the Amateur Select or Amateur Class. In the event a class offered on the show bill as amateur select and amateur are combined at the show, WQHA points will be awarded to the respective age group. Jumping and Team Penning may only be offered as all-age classes. *If the Select Amateur contestant neglects to designate on the official WQHA Show Entry Form indicating which division they will be competing for WQHA year end all around, the points chair will post points to Amateur or Amateur Select according to the exhibitor's age. These points stand once posted.*

Any of the Amateur Performance AQHA approved classes may also be offered at the show management's discretion in the Amateur Select, Novice Amateur and Rookie divisions. The WQHA suggests shows offer classes in these divisions. In the Amateur Halter events, shows may offer the halter classes as Yearlings, 2 year olds, 3 year olds, Aged, and Performance. In the Amateur Division, halter classes will be offered for Stallions, Mares, and Geldings.

21B. In the event a Youth Activity Performance class offered on the show bill as 13 & under and 14-18 are combined at the show, WQHA points will be awarded to the respective age group.

Any of the Youth Performance AQHA approved classes may also be offered at the show management's discretion in the Novice Youth and Rookie divisions. The WQHA suggests shows offer classes in these divisions. In the Youth Halter events, shows may offer the classes as Yearlings, 2 year olds, 3 year olds, Aged, and Performance. In the Youth Division, halter classes will be offered for Mares, and Geldings.

Age group limits in Youth Activity events may be set by the show management. In no case, however, shall any contestant be more than 18 years of age. For horse show purposes, the age of an individual on January 1 of that year shall be maintained throughout the entire year. (Example: A youngster who has a birthday in July and is 18 years of age on January 1, 2017 may show throughout the entire year of 2017 as an 18 year old). Youth classes may be offered as 18 & under, or 13 & under and 14 -18.

22. SMALL FRY 10 and Under: The following listed Small Fry classes are suggested classes.

- a. Small Fry Showmanship
- b. Small Fry Trail
- c. Small Fry Western Pleasure
- d. Small Fry Western Horsemanship
- e. Small Fry Hunter Under Saddle
- f. Small Fry Equitation

The WQHA suggests shows offer classes in the Small Fry division. Rules of ownership for the Small Fry division are the same as any other youth showing in the AQHA approved youth classes. Small Fry classes are point classes for year-end WQHA awards, providing they are offered under 10 judges during the current year at approved shows. Year-end awards are to be presented to the high point horse/rider combination in each WQHA approved Small Fry class with a suitable award to the second (reserve) high point in each WQHA approved class. Any first or second place horse that was not shown to at least 10 judges and earned at least 20 WQHA points in that class during the current year at approved shows will receive a lesser year end award.

Riders may also show in AQHA halter or showmanship classes, but not any class in which the canter or lope is required.

23. Lead Line ages 7 and under: Riders must control the horse at the walk, and back if asked. Handlers are there for safety, lead line handlers should be 18 years of age or older. Halters should be placed under the bridle, handlers are expected to maintain control of their horses at all times. Riders are not required to own their mount to qualify for participation awards. This is not a WQHA approved class—awards are presented if an individual or, group is willing to defray the cost.

24. Entries are submitted per show(s) i.e. single, split combined, or multiple judged. Exhibitors have the option to enter all of their classes for the circuit in advance. Entries are to be made at the show office or in some instances pre-entries via the internet may be offered. All scratches must be made at the show office. Failure to scratch at the show office prior to the start of a class will make the exhibitor liable for the entry fee(s).



25. ELIGIBILITY FOR WQHA POINTS AND AWARDS: In order to be eligible to acquire WQHA points, monies or awards, both the owner(s) and exhibitor must be members in good standing of the Association. All members and exhibitors regardless of residence location are eligible to receive points for the year-end awards. In order for a horse to earn said points, all parties listed as owner on the Certificate of Registration must be members of the WQHA. The points for WQHA shows held after the last weekend in October through December will count toward year-end awards in the following year. **POINTS WILL BE AWARDED ONLY IN WQHA APPROVED SHOWS.**

WQHA points will be awarded in each of the listed classes on the following basis:

One point extra in each place, for each five extra horses. The Grand Champion of each sex division will receive at least one point more than any other horse in its sex division. If necessary, additional points will be added to the points the Grand Champion won in its age class to give it this total. The Reserve Champion of each sex division will receive as many points as any horse in its sex division except the Grand Champion. If necessary, additional points will be added to the points the Reserve Champion won in its age class to give it this total.

YEAR-END AWARDS

Points are to be accumulated from the date of the postmark on the envelope in which the current year's dues are received by the membership chairman, or the date of the receipt issued by the membership chairman or his assistant. The membership chairman shall retain all envelopes for proof of dates. Any one making dues payments to someone other than the membership chairman does so at his or her own risk, it is up to exhibitor to ensure memberships have been received and recorded.

Year-end awards are to be presented to the high point horse in each WQHA approved performance and halter class with a suitable award to the second (reserve) high point in each WQHA approved class. Any first or second place horse that was not shown to at least 10 judges and earned at least 20 WQHA points in that class during the current year at approved shows will receive a lesser year end award.

Year-end awards are to be presented to:

- High point youth, novice youth and rookie youth horse/rider combination
- High point amateur, amateur select, novice amateur and rookie amateur horse/rider combination
- High Point All age Awards will be presented to the High Point All age Halter Stallion, High Point All age Halter Mare, and High Point All age Halter Gelding with points earned from the open division halter classes
- All-Around Open Champion award will be awarded to the horse winning the most points in halter classes and at least two performance classes during the year. At least 10 points must be won in each class (halter and each of the two performance classes). All performance classes count excluding the Youth Activity and Amateur Classes. The WQHA will also recognize the Reserve All-Around Open Champion winning the second most points and meeting the requirements above with a suitable award.
- A WQHA Champion award will be awarded to each horse earning 200 WQHA points, with at least 50 points earned in halter classes, at least 50 points earned in one AQHA approved performance event, and at least 25 points in another AQHA approved performance event, excluding youth activity, amateur, and novice classes. Points earned in previous years will count toward this award. Only one WQHA 200 Point Champion award will be awarded to each horse. Points will not begin to accumulate until a horse becomes a yearling.
- A year-end All-Around Amateur Champion award will be awarded to the Amateur horse and rider combination winning the most points in at least three amateur classes during the year. At least 10 points must be won in each class. The WQHA will also recognize the Reserve All-Around Amateur Champion winning the second most points in at least three amateur classes during the year with a suitable award.

- A year-end All-Around Select Amateur Champion award will be awarded to the Select Amateur rider and horse combination winning the most points in at least three amateur select classes during the year. At least 10 points must be won in each class. Any points won in Amateur classes that do not have a corresponding Select Amateur class listed on the show bill (i.e. halter, hunter classes, ranch classes, reining and so forth) will be added to the Amateur Select rider and horse combination point total. These classes will count towards the three class minimum if at least 10 points are won in the class. The WQHA will also recognize the Reserve All-Around Select Amateur Champion winning the second most points and meeting the requirements above with a suitable award. *(If the Select Amateur contestant neglects to designate on the official WQHA Show Entry Form indicating which division they will be competing for WQHA year end all around, the points chair will post points to Amateur or Amateur Select according to the exhibitor's age. These point stand once posted.)*
- A WQHA Champion award will be awarded to each Amateur horse and rider combination earning 200 WQHA points in amateur classes, with at least 50 points earned in halter classes, at least 50 points earned in one AQHA approved performance event, and at least 25 points earned in another AQHA approved performance event. These points began to accumulate on January 1, 1989. Only one 200 point champion award will be awarded to each horse/rider combination.
- A year-end All-Around Youth 14-18 Champion award and an All-Around Youth 13 & under Champion award will be given to the Youth rider and horse combinations winning the most points in at least three Youth 14-18 classes or three Youth 13 & Under classes. At least 10 points must be won in each class. Any points won in Youth All Age classes (i.e. halter, hunter classes, ranch classes, reining and so forth) will be added to the respective age group. Youth All Age classes will count towards the three class minimum if at least 10 points are won in each class. The WQHA will also recognize the Reserve All-Around Youth 14-18 and the Reserve All-Around Youth 13 & Under winning the second most points and meeting the requirements above with a suitable award.
- A WQHA Champion award will be awarded to each Youth horse and rider combination earning 300 WQHA points in youth classes, with at least 50 points earned in halter classes, at least 50 points earned in one AQHA approved performance event, and at least 25 points earned in another AQHA performance event. Only one 300 point champion award will be awarded to each horse and rider combination. Novice amateur and novice youth points do not transfer to their respective 200/300 point awards. Youth points do not transfer to amateur. Small Fry points do not transfer to Youth. Points will be compiled on a one horse—one youth basis in youth activity events, one horse-one amateur/amateur select in amateur events.
- A year-end Novice All-Around Youth Champion award and Novice All-Around Amateur Champion award will be given to the Novice rider and horse combinations winning the most points in at least three Novice classes. At least 10 points must be won in each class. Only classes designated as Novice will count towards the Novice All-Around Champion awards. The WQHA will also recognize the Reserve Novice All-Around Youth Champion and the Reserve Novice All-Around Amateur Champion winning the second most points and meeting the requirements above with a suitable award.
- A year-end Rookie All-Around Youth Champion award and Rookie All-Around Amateur Champion award will be given to the Rookie rider and horse combinations winning the most points in at least three Rookie classes. At least 10 points must be won in each class. Only classes designated as Rookie will count towards the Rookie All-Around Champion awards. The WQHA will also recognize the Reserve Rookie All-Around Youth Champion and the Reserve Rookie All-Around Amateur Champion winning the second most points and meeting the requirements above with a suitable award.
- Wisconsin Bred High Point Open, Amateur and Youth Award. To be eligible for this award, the breeder, as listed on the horse's Certificate of Registration, must be located in Wisconsin.
- High Point Wisconsin Bred Horse award will be awarded to the horse earning the most points in open classes during the year. Points earned in Level 1 classes will not be included.
- High Point Wisconsin Bred Amateur award will be awarded to the horse/rider combination earning the most points in Amateur and Select Amateur classes during the year. Points earned in Non-Pro Walk Trot, Rookie, and Level 1 classes will not be included.
- High Point Wisconsin Bred Youth award will be awarded to the horse/rider combination earning the most points in Youth 13 & Under, Youth 14-18 and All Age Youth classes during the year. Points earned in Non-Pro Walk Trot, Rookie and Level 1 classes will not be included.

AQHA Recognition

The WQHA will recognize with a suitable award certificate at the Annual Awards Banquet the following horses earning AQHA Recognition:

1. National High Point Stallion, Mare and Gelding in any halter or performance class earning this title in the current year and owned by a member of the WQHA.

Note: It will be the owner's responsibility to notify the Awards chairman if a horse has earned any of these AQHA awards. A copy of the AQHA show record must accompany said notification.



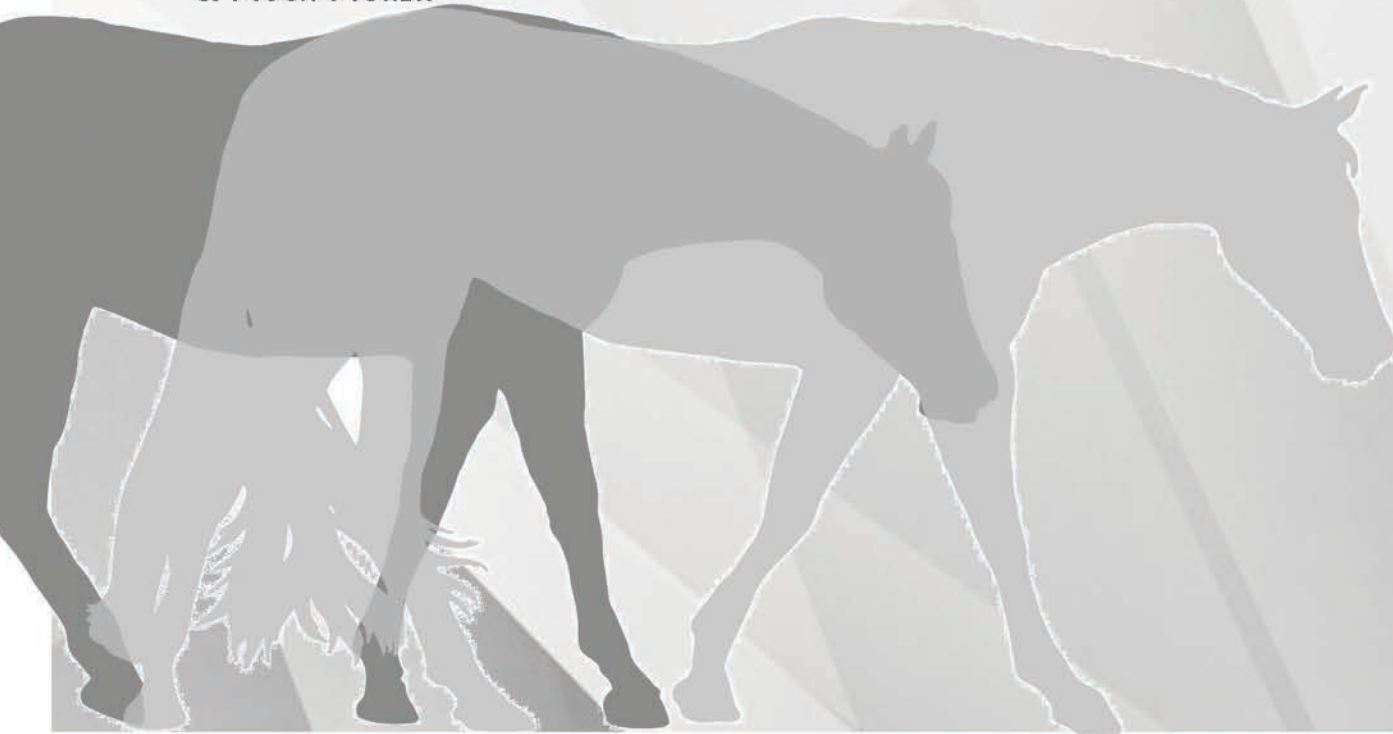
