- Kendall: silent auction-we need donations
- Person at out gate
- Jen: will bring minifridge, microwave and electric cooler for judge's room
- Leah: purchase snacks and water for judges. If a judge would like a soda, will be purchased from lunch stand
- Gwen: coffee supplies
- Jen: coffee maker
- Showmanship walker
- Stall counter: someone will need to go around daily to verify stall count and use of any empty stalls
- Jen: shovels, broom, pitchforks
- Sweep by show office before and/or after show
- Gwen: check with Bridgeway or other hotel that provides breakfast for judges and staff

Circuit awards:

- Power banks
