Find your AQHA Level for 2017

When entering American Quarter Horse Association classes, AQHA exhibitors and American Quarter Horse owners are required to provide proof of their level eligibility to show management. Exhibitors and owners must print their level eligibility to give to show management during the 2017 show season. To determine level eligibility for 2017, visit <u>www.aqha.com/leveling</u> to access the Web-based AQHA leveling verification system.
