AQHA's Ranching Heritage Young Horse Development Program - One of the winner's was from Wisconsin! We met Molly Witzeling at Midwest Horse and asked her to share some information on this program and her progress. My name is Molly Witzeling and I was selected to participate in the American Quarter Horse Association's Ranching Heritage Young Horse Development Program. I received a sorrel, weanling colt from Raymond Sutton Ranch in Gettysburg, South Dakota. His registered name is RWS Dreams Come True aka Ahmyr and he is currently 11 months old. I have to write monthly reports on him, tune into web-seminars, and log our progress. The monthly reports will be graded, because I am able to win scholarships from the writing. Lately we have been working on picking hooves, which he has gotten much better at. We have also been working on leading because he gets afraid of noise behind him, which

isn't that uncommon because horses are prey animals. I am learning so much, like how to take care of a colt after being castrated and to problem solve with different situations. He enjoys being groomed, especially with the shedding season upon us. I come out to the barn at least 3-4 times a week and just spend time with him. He is very loving, and they learn so quickly at this age. I highly recommend applying for this program, and all your hard work does pay off. It is extremely rewarding to see how far we have come since that late December night when he stepped off the trailer. You learn as well as the horse all through the whole process. I thank AQHA for letting me participate in this program and for the amazing opportunities this will provide.


